

Scheduling Group Tours for Adults

Guided tours for 8 persons or more are available during Museum weekday hours: Tuesday through Friday, 10 AM-5 PM (except Friday 12:30-1:30 PM). Weekend hours are Saturday 10-5 and Sunday 1-5 (latest admission 4 PM). (Please note that, because our guides are volunteers, it may not be possible to provide guided tours on weekends.) The Museum is closed on Mondays and major holidays.

Reservations are necessary for all guided tours and for self-guided groups of 8 or more. Please make reservations at least 4-6 weeks in advance to ensure that the desired date is available, and to allow us to schedule our guides. We accept reservations up to six months in advance.

Gallery Deposit & Minimum Tour Fee of \$56.00 (equivalent to admission for 8 adults) must be paid before tour is confirmed. No group will be admitted without a confirmation. Deposit will be credited at admission and forfeited if the tour is canceled less than two weeks in advance. (Refund of deposit, or application to a future tour, will be considered if special circumstances warrant.)

Tour fee is included in individual Museum admission:

Adult Admission \$7 per person

Senior/Student Admission \$6 per person

(Tour leader admitted free of charge)

To avoid delays at admission, the tour leader should collect all individual fees prior to museum entry. **Discounts, special offers, and Museum memberships do not apply to group tour fees.**

Financial assistance is available from our Scholarship Fund under special circumstances.

Group size: Museum can accommodate one busload (50 persons). In order to ensure a quality tour experience, groups of more than 25 will be split into two rotating tours. Please allow about one hour to tour, plus extra time to visit the Museum Store and restrooms.

The Museum has **no eating facilities**. A list of local restaurants is available on request. Groups may also picnic on the Museum grounds or in nearby Bruce Park.

Accessibility: The Museum is compliant with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA). All exhibitions are on the first floor of the building, restrooms are wheelchair accessible, and a wheelchair ramp is located to the left of the main entrance. A wheelchair is available on request.
